MEETING MINUTES

The Virginia Board for Asbestos, Lead, and Home Inspectors met on November 4, 2003 in Conference Room 4 West at the offices of the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, 3600 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia.

Chairperson Mentz, finding a quorum of the Board present, called <u>Call to Order</u> the meeting to order at 9:02 AM.

Mr. Nott moved that the Board approve the agenda as prepared by Adopt Agenda Mr. Geller seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by six aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Gerow, Nott, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz). The agenda is attached.

Mr. Geller moved that the Board approve the minutes of its August 27, 2003 meeting. Mr. Nott seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by six aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Gerow, Nott, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz).

Approval of Board Minutes

Mr. Geller moved that the Board approve the minutes of the September 11, 2003 IFF. Mr. Crockett seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously by six aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Gerow, Nott, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz).

Chairperson Mentz opened the floor for public comment. No Public Comment member of the public present expressed a desire to address the Period Board.

In the matter of File Number 2004-00160, Board v. Joseph ReZel Blackley, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding Board member's summary and recommendation. Joseph ReZel Blackley (Respondent) was not present. Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Mr. Nott, the Board adopted the summary and recommendation, and approved the application for Asbestos Supervisor license for Joseph ReZel Blackley. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Gerow, Nott, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Arrival of Board Member

In the matter of File Number 2004-00166, Board v. Jose File Number Roberto Platero Delgado, the Board reviewed the record, which 2004-00166 consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding Board member's summary and recommendation. Jose Roberto Platero Delgado (Respondent) addressed the Board. Upon a motion by Mr. Nott and seconded by Mr. Gerow, the Board adopted the summary but rejected the recommendation. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Gerow, Nott, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

Upon a motion by Mr. Nott and seconded by Mr. Gerow, the Board recommended approving Mr. Delgado for an Asbestos Supervisor license. The motion passed unanimously. Members

voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Gerow, Nott, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

The Board agreed without dissent to request that staff make a recommendation at its February meeting on how the Board through staff should address training providers with regards to English-only training courses. They stressed that Supervisor courses must be taught in English only with no assistance given with the end-of-class exam and no translation assistance be given.

In the matter of File Number 2004-00898, Board v. Fredy Rolando Iboy, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of 2004-00898 the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding Board member's summary and recommendation. Fredy Rolando Iboy (Respondent) was not present. Upon a motion by Mr. Crockett and seconded by Mr. Nott, the Board adopted the summary and recommendation, and approved the application for Asbestos Worker license for Fredy Rolando Iboy. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Gerow, Nott, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

File Number

In the matter of File Number 2004-00899, Board v. Larry Calvin Pinkney, the Board reviewed the record, which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF, and the presiding Board member's summary and recommendation. Larry Calvin Pinkney (Respondent) addressed the Board. Upon a motion by Mr. Heppner and seconded by Mr. Gerow, the Board adopted the summary and recommendation, and approved the application for Asbestos Worker license for Larry Calvin Pinkney. The motion passed unanimously. Members voting "YES" were Messrs. Crockett, Gerow, Nott, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz. The presiding Board member, Mr. Geller, left the room and did not participate in the discussion or vote.

File Number 2004-00899

Sharon Sweet updated the Board on the new Lead Examination Lead Examination developed by Professional Credential Services, Inc. (PCS). The new Lead Examination will be implemented on January 1, 2004. PCS will administer the exam daily by computer at 11 examination sites throughout the state. Ms. Sweet expressed thanks to Mr. Perry and Mr. Gerow for their help in reviewing

Update

300 questions that were added to the examination item bank.

Sharon Sweet discussed three different groups that requested to **Home Inspector** have their examinations approved by the Board. Mr. Crockett Examination moved that the Board not approve The National Association of Equivalency Certified Home Inspectors examination, the Pillar to Post Professional Home Inspection examination, and the Housing Inspection Foundation examination at this time since they are not substantially equivalent to the currently approved examinations. Heppner seconded the motion which was carried Mr. unanimously by seven aye votes (Messrs. Crockett, Geller, Gerow, Nott, Heppner, and Honeycutt; and Ms. Mentz).

Mr. Kossan updated the Board on the National Asbestos Other Business Conference which was hosted by Virginia on October 28-30, 2003 in Virginia Beach. Topics of concern discussed at the conference included: the use of fraudulent training certificates and invalid Social Security numbers; asbestos-related diseases from a mine in Libby, Montana where vermiculite was mined which contained tremolite; and a congressional bill sponsored by Senator Murray which would eliminate asbestos by ceasing the manufacturing of asbestos products and removing existing asbestos from the environment.

Concern was expressed at the Conference that Charter Schools were not following AHERA requirements to have in place an Inspection and Management Plan.

Mr. Kossan said that MAREC held its annual meeting of EPA Region III states on the evening before the National Conference. There was a discussion concerning the continued use of fraudulent training certificates and invalid Social Security numbers.
