Regulation & Compliance Enforcement Updates - Ron Passmore, Division Director

Division Update(s)

- 1. Update Tidewater Program Rep/Investigator Chad Gregg came onboard to R&C division in September 2021.
- 2. Update on DEA/BOP/OEMS Taskforce activities
  - a. Virginia Board of Pharmacy EMS Agency specific guidance document published on townhall –2 year approach with Reg & Comp Staff and regional councils to assist agencies with obtaining the appropriate Virginia BOP CSRC
  - b. Meeting with Virginia DEA agents assigned to EMS Agencies met with R&C last month and determined that they will only be approaching EMS agencies that currently hold a DEA registration.
  - c. Compliance Plan Virginia BOP DEA Still awaiting final DEA rules change regarding hospital provided regional drug boxes for EMS.

# Ongoing Regulatory activities

- 3. Proposed Regulation RIS Project 5100 (Chapter 32) final edits completed: reduced regulations by 20%. Advised if any changes from stage 2 to stage 3 due to public comments, the project will likely have to start over.
  - a. EMS for Children will provide language tomorrow for sections 710 & 860; regarding child restraint regulation(s) yet to be added to Chapter 32
    - Review this draft over the next 3 months to make final suggested edits at the next Rules & Reg's meeting.
  - b. Review of Chapter 32 draft regulations and Chapter 31 to 32 comparison document.
    - Specific Review of Medivac Committee's requested changes:

### Section 850: Air Medical Service Personnel Classifications

- \* 1.b.1 Board prepared physician
- \* 1.b.2 Nurses/Paramedics Increase requirement of 3 years' experience up from 2
- \* 1.c Attendant add language to read "may be a Paramedic or Registered Nurse"
- \* 4.- Staffing for Specific Mission Types regarding who must serve as AIC has been deleted from Chapter 32 Scene Flight nor IFT's specify who must serve as AIC

### **Section 860: Training**

C.6 – Increase requirement from 6 months to 12 months' for RN's to obtain EMS certification, post hire by Air Medical EMS Agency.

Proposed plan is to resume RIS Project 5100 and enter Stage 2 of the regulatory process

- 4. Negotiate final edits during the April 2022 Committee meetings.
- 5. Present final agreed to draft as a Rules & Reg's action item to the full State EMS Advisory Board at our July Committee Meeting
- 6. Submit to EMS Advisory Board as action item at the August 2022 Board Meeting
  - a. Then submit Project 5100 (Chapter 32 Draft) to VDH Board of Health for approval

Ongoing Regulation & Compliance Enforcement activities

- 7. Variance/Exemption Request Reviews
  - a. 3 agencies from Brunswick County requesting exemption from ALS ambulance staffing requirements (section 1250) historical perspective this exemption first granted 2014.
