The Board reviewed a summary of Hearing Aid Specialists Regulations effective October 1, 2003. A summary will be distributed with Regulations regulations.

Summary of

Mr. Nick Christner, Director of the Compliance and Investigation Compliance and Division, fielded questions regarding the complaint and investigation Investigation process and the changes occurring within the Compliance and Investigation Division.

Mr. Christner informed the Board that the Compliance and Investigation Division is working closely with the DPOR Process Improvement Team to continue to enact procedures to expedite the process and make the process more consumer friendly.

The Board took under consideration legislation for the 2005 General Legislation Assembly. Ms. Ryals gave an overview of the legislative process and legislation pertaining to the Board. Upon a motion by Ms. Kearney and seconded by Mr. Frank. The Board voted to support a bill to amend and reenact §§ 54.1-1504 of the Code of Virginia to require licensure for the fitting or dealing of hearing aids in that this legislation would amend the language of 'fitting and selling of hearing aids' to 'fitting or selling of hearing aids'. The members voting 'yes' were Mr. Frank, Ms. Harvey, Mr. Kessler, Ms. Kearney, Dr. Linde, and Mr. Michie. There were no negative votes. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board reviewed a draft of a consumer information flyer, What Consumer Should I Know...About Buying A Heating Aid, and made recommendations for revisions. Staff will make revisions and the flyer will be posted on the DPOR's website under News and Consumer Information.
