### **MEETING MINUTES**

The Virginia Board for Waste Management Facility Operators met on Wednesday, September 28, 2005 at 10:00 AM, in Conference Room 4 West at the offices of the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, 3600 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia.

In the absence of Chairperson Dan Miles, Vice Chairperson W. A. Call to Order Dennison finding a quorum of the Board present, called the meeting to order at 10:10 AM.

Mr. Kyle moved that the Board approve the agenda as prepared by Adopt Agenda staff. Ms Jacobs seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved by the following members: Jacobs, Brandon, Kyle, Dieter and Dennison.

Ms Jacobs moved that the Board approve the minutes of its Approval of September 29, 2004 meeting, the Public Hearing of August 11, Minutes 2005 and the IFF minutes of September 1, 2005. Mr. Brandon seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved by the

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following members: Jacobs, Brandon, Kyle, Dieter and Dennison.

Chairperson Dennison opened the floor for public comment. No Public Comment members of the public were present.

Period

In the matter of File Number 2006-00386, Jeffrey Phillips, the Board reviewed the record which consisted of the application file, transcript and exhibits from the IFF and the presiding officer's summary and recommendation. Mr. Milton Brown, Operations Manager for Waste Management and Respondent Jeffrey Phillips, were present and addressed the Board. Mr. Brandon moved that the Board accept the presiding officer's summary recommendation and approve the application for Class II Waste Management Facility Operator's License for Jeffrey Phillips. Mr. Dieter seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following members: Brandon, Kyle, Jacobs, Dieter and Dennison.

File Number 2006-00386

The Board received training course application for Class II training from Earth Compliance Solutions. Subsequent to receipt, Mr. Miles and Mr. Dennison reviewed the application recommended approval of the application. Mr. Kyle moved that the Board accept the recommendations and approve Earth Compliance Solutions Class II training. Mr. Brandon seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following members: Brandon, Kyle, Jacobs, Dieter and Dennison.

**Training Course Application** 

David Dick provided the Board with the public comments received during the public comment period on its proposed regulation amendments and a draft Summary of Public Comment and Agency Response. The Board reviewed the pubic comments and the draft Summary of Public Comment and Agency Response.

**Proposed Regulatory Action** 

Mr. Kyle moved that the Board adopt the Summary of Public Comment and Agency Response drafted by staff with additional input from the Board. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brandon and unanimously approved by the following members: Brandon, Kyle, Jacobs, Dieter and Dennison.

**Summary of Public** Comment and **Agency Response** Adopted

The Board reviewed its proposed regulation amendments and deleted all language concerning the creation of a separate class of license for municipal solid waste composting. Section 18 VAC 155-20-120.B.4. was amended to add the word "operational" after "verified" and before "experience" to make clear that experience

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must involve the actual operation of a waste management facility in order to qualify.

The Board noted that there is no strong support for creating a separate license class for municipal solid waste composting but that there is strong and compelling opposition. A separate class is not economically justified at this time.

Mr. Dieter moved that the Board adopt as final regulation the proposed regulation as amended by the Board during the meeting. Ms. Jacobs seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following members: Brandon, Kyle, Jacobs, Dieter and Dennison.

Ms. Jacobs moved that Mr. Miles and Mr. Dennison continue as the Board Chair and Vice Chair, respectively. Mr. Kyle seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the following members: Brandon, Kyle, Jacobs, Dieter and Dennison.

**Other Business** 

The next meeting of the Board will be as called for by the Chair.

David Dick made a presentation to the Board members on its and responsibilities and process associated with carrying out their duties.

**Board Member Training** 

Vice Chairperson Dennison asked the Board members to complete their conflict of interest forms and travel vouchers.
