This letter is sent as notification that the Education Informal Conference Committee of the Virginia Board of Nursing will consider the proposal to establish an additional program track submitted by John Tyler Community College, Midiothian for a part time associate degree nursing education program. The committee will meet at 9:00 a.m. on March 14, 2018 at Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Training Room 1, in Henrico.

In an effort to facilitate a more complete review of educational programs, the Board of Nursing has established the procedure which is reflected in this letter. This allows for a careful review of each curriculum change, the opportunity for you to be present, if you wish, and for you to participate in the process with the Committee.

While your attendance is not required, you may be present when the program is considered by the Committee. Attending the meeting will give you the opportunity to make comments about the curriculum and respond to questions from the Committee. Questions from the Committee that cannot be answered by the material provided may result in a deferral of the Board's decision in the absence of a representative from the program. Please let us know by March 1, 2018 if you plan to be present.

After the Committee reviews the curriculum information, the Committee will develop a recommendation for presentation to the Board at its meeting on March 27, 2018.

The Committee will make one of the following recommendations to the Board:

To grant approval of a part time associate degree nursing education program as an additional track for the ADN program; or

To recommend that the program submit an application to establish a part time associate degree education program.

The Board of Nursing will take action on the recommendation from the Committee. The procedure is consistent with the Nurse Practice Act, the Board of Nursing Regulations and the Virginia Administrative Process Act in that it provides for an informal conference for the initial decision while allowing for the Board or a panel thereof to consider the matter in a formal hearing if agreement is not reached informally.

In any instance where an adverse recommendation is accepted by the Board of Nursing, within thirty-three (33) days of the date of the order/action, the program director may request a hearing before the Board or a panel thereof, in accordance with Virginia Code §2.2-4020 and §54.1-2400 (11).

Bon Secours Memorial College of Nursing

Bon Secours Memorial College of Nursing was granted College accreditation by the Accrediting Bureau of Health and Education Schools (ABHES) on November 21, 2017. The College previously had accreditation through the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACISC). The nursing program maintains accreditation through the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). The notification letter from the program director dated January 9, 2018 is enclosed.

Global Health College

Global Health College voluntarily withdrew from the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACISC). Because of the voluntary withdrawal from the accrediting body of the College, the practical nursing program voluntarily withdrew their nursing program accreditation with the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN). Letters of notification from the program director dated November 27, 2017 and December 15, 2017 are enclosed.
