#### Summary

As of a result of actions by the 2013 General Assembly (HB2048 & SB 1279) certain water quality programs previously administered by the Department of Conservation and Recreation will now be administered by the Department of Environmental Quality. The Department of Environmental Quality and the State Water Control Board will have oversight of water quality planning and laws dealing with stormwater management, erosion and sediment control and the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Areas.

In this regulatory action Code references for the Stormwater Management Regulations have been changed from Title 10.1 to 62.1 and section references have been changed from 4VAC50-60 to 9VAC25-870 to reflect the change in administration of the program from the Department of Conservation and Recreation and the Soil and Water Conservation Board to the Department of Environmental Quality and the State Water Control Board.

The State Water Control Board adopted the regulations at its August 26-27, 2013 Board Meeting.

Code references for the Stormwater Management Regulations have been changed from Article 1.1 to Article 2.3; Chapter 6 to Chapter 3.1; Title 10.1 to 62.1 and section references have been changed from 4VAC50-60 to 9VAC25-870 to reflect the change in administration of the program from the Department of Conservation and Recreation and the Soil and Water Conservation Board to the Department of Environmental Quality and the State Water Control Board. Section numbers follow those found in 4VAC50-60 where possible to facilitate the transfer of administration of the regulations. References to the Department of Conservation and Recreation and the Soil and Water Conservation Board have been revised to the Department of Environmental Quality and the State Water Control Board. Code references for terms that are defined in the Definition Section (9VAC25-870-10) by reference to a specific Code section have been deleted. In addition references to specific dates for CFR references have been deleted to conform to common practice and a new section establishing the date for CFR references has been added.

It is not anticipated that this regulatory action will have any impacts on the family and family stability.
