I have reviewed the amendments to the Regulations Governing the Practice of Professional Counseling, 18VAC115-20, the Regulations Governing the Certification of Substance Abuse Counselors and Substance Abuse Counseling Assistants, 18VAC115-30, the Regulations Governing the Certification of Rehabilitation Providers, 18VAC115-40, the Regulations Governing the Practice of Marriage and Family Therapy, 18VAC115-50, the Regulations Governing the Practice of Licensed Substance Abuse Treatment Practitioners, 18VAC115-60, the Regulations Governing the Registration of Peer Recovery Specialists, 18VAC115-70, and the Regulations Governing the Registration of Qualified Mental Health Professionals, 18VAC115-80, as adopted by the Board of Counseling on November 22, 2019. The Board has the statutory authority to adopt these Regulations under Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4805 and 54.1-2400. The proposed amendments are constitutional and do not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
