- **SUBJECT:** Regulations Governing the Practice of Physician Assistants 18VAC85-50-10 et seq.

I have reviewed the proposed amendment to the Regulations Governing the Practice of Physician Assistants, 18VAC85-50-10 *et seq*. The proposed amendment eliminates the requirement for a supervising physician signature on prescriptions written by a physician assistant for Schedule VI drugs, and further provides clarification on the manner of compliance with the disclosure requirement contained in Virginia Code § 54.1-2952.1. The Board has the statutory authority to amend this regulation under Virginia Code §§ 54.1-2400 and 54.1-2952.1. The proposed amendment is constitutional and does not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
