The Board of Pharmacy has amended regulations governing collaborative practice agreements pursuant to legislation during the 2025 General Assembly Session. [HB1582](#) clarified that pharmacists' participation in collaborative practice agreements includes prescribing medication. The Board amended portions of 18VAC110-40 to reflect that clarification.

While not a mandated change, [HB1582](#) clarified that pharmacists’ participation in collaborative practice agreements includes prescribing medication. The Board amended portions of 18VAC110-40 to reflect that clarification.
