On page 4 of the document under section 320, DPB references nitrous-nitrate; please note the accurate terminology is nitrate-nitrogen (NO₃-N).

Although an adverse impact is indicated because there are costs associated with this action, the agency notes these costs are minimal, the regulatory changes reflect good public policy and public health protection for those supporting the agricultural industry of Virginia, and the changes proposed involved robust stakeholder and industry engagement.
