RE: Commonwealth of Virginia, Department of Historic Resources – Amendment to

the Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit Regulations

We have reviewed the information made available to our office in the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall (<a href="http://townhall.virginia.gov/">http://townhall.virginia.gov/</a>) concerning the removal of reference dates for incorporated documents from the historic rehabilitation tax credit regulations in 17 VAC 10-30-50. Based on the review, we believe that you, as Director of the Department of Historic Resources, may take this action pursuant to Virginia Code § 58.1-339.2(E) which provides, in part, that "[t]he Director of the Department of Historic Resources shall establish by regulation the requirements needed for th[e historic rehabilitation tax credit] program."
