SUBJECT: Proposed amendments to General Rules and Regulations of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, 24 VAC 30-21

In my capacity as legal counsel for the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) and the Commonwealth Transportation Board, it is my legal opinion that the proposed amendments to the General Rules and Regulations of the Commonwealth Transportation Board do not appear, on its face, to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor does it appear to conflict with federal or state law currently in effect.

Virginia Code § 33.2-210 provides that the Commonwealth Transportation Board has the power and duty to make regulations that are not in conflict with the laws of the Commonwealth for the protection of and covering traffic on and for the use of systems of state highways and shall have the authority to add to, amend, or repeal such regulations.

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
