The Virginia Marine Resources Commission (VMRC) is amending Chapter 4 VAC 20-1140-10 et seq., "Prohibition of Crab Dredging in Virginia Waters", closing the December 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024 winter commercial crab dredge fishing season, in accordance with the provisions of Section 28.2-707 of the Code of Virginia.

Mandate and Impetus

[Mandate] VMRC is authorized by § 28.2-201 of the Code of Virginia to promulgate regulations and guidelines necessary to carry out the provisions of Title 28.2, including marine fisheries regulations.

[Impetus] Juvenile abundance in the 2023 Chesapeake Bay-wide winter dredge survey was estimated at 116 million crabs. This value is among the lowest values of the winter dredge survey, though higher than the abundances in 2021 and 2022. Blue crab abundance, especially in juveniles, experiences strong inter-annual variability due to natural processes. A winter dredge fishery season, especially when juvenile abundance is low, could negatively affect subsequent spawning events and crab pot harvest.
