You ask whether the Virginia Board of Education possesses the requisite statutory authority to promulgate regulations governing special education.

Section 22.1-16 vests the Board of Education with the authority to promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry out its powers and duties and the provisions of Title 22.1. In my view, therefore, the Board possesses the requisite authority to promulgate these regulations.
