The 2014 General Assembly passed, and the Governor signed into law, HB449, which amends the Code of Virginia by adding § 22.1-287.01. The new section provides that, "Except as required by federal law or regulation, no member or employee of a local school board or the Department of Education shall transmit personally identifiable information, as that term is defined in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. § 1232g) and related regulations, from a student's record to a federal government agency or an authorized representative of such agency." The amendment to 8 VAC 20-150-20 brings existing regulations into conformance with the requirements of the Code of Virginia.

The Virginia Board of Education approved the changes to the Management of the Student's Scholastic Record in the Public Schools of Virginia on November 20, 2014.
