VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-415

SUBJECT: Inspection Procedures for Occupational Exposure to Methylene Chloride Final Rule, §§

1910.1052, 1915.1052 and 1926.1152

A. Purpose.

This directive transmits to field personnel guidelines for a uniform enforcement of the Occupational Exposure to Methylene Chloride Standard, as amended in the Federal Register (September 22, 1998, pages 50711-50732), by setting enforcement policy, providing inspection guidelines, and clarifying and interpreting the regulatory text.

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

B. Scope.

This directive applies to all VOSH personnel, and specifically to Occupational Health Compliance and Consultation Services personnel.
