



### VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 03-101

### **ISSUED**: September 15, 1991

**<u>SUBJECT</u>**: Guidelines on the Stability of Well Servicing Derricks

### A. <u>Purpose</u>.

This directive provides guidelines to compliance officers, consultants, employers, and employees on the stability of well servicing derricks.

This program directive is an internal guideline not a statutory or regulatory rule and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

### B. <u>Scope</u>.

This Program Directive applies VOSH-wide.
