BOARD FOR BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGY APPLICATION REVIEW MATRIX CRIMINAL HISTORY AND PRIOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Effective	May 9, 2022	

The following convictions will not be reviewed by the Board*:

- 1. Felony convictions more than 10 years old with no subsequent reportable convictions of a similar nature, unless the conviction resulted in incarceration where the release date is less than three years from the application date.
- 2. Felony convictions more than five years old with no subsequent reportable convictions of a similar nature, unless the conviction resulted in incarceration where the release date is less than three years from the application date. This does not include convictions involving murder, sexual assault, rape, robbery, indecent liberties, fraud.
- 3. Felony convictions for distribution of controlled substance, where the applicant has completed a deterrence program if required by the court.
- 4. Misdemeanor convictions
- 5. Juvenile convictions.
- 6. Drug possession convictions.
- 7. Prior disciplinary action only involving monetary penalties that do not involve client safety.
- 8. The provisions above notwithstanding, staff may refer matters to the Board based on the totality of an applicant's criminal history where there appears to be substantial risk of public harm.

^{*}The matrix shall not apply to applicants who are currently incarcerated, except those incarcerated for juvenile convictions.
