Submission of Evidence of Completion of Graduate Work

Regulations for licensure in psychology (18VAC125-20-41) require every applicant for examination for licensure to submit the following:

- a. A completed application on forms provided by the board;
- b. A completed residency agreement or documentation of having fulfilled the experience requirements of 18VAC125-20-65;
- c. The application processing fee prescribed by the board; and
- d. Official transcripts documenting the graduate work completed and the degree awarded.

If an applicant has completed ALL degree requirements, but the graduate transcript does not <u>document</u> that the degree has been awarded solely because of the institution's schedule for conferring degrees, the requirement may be met by submission of an official letter from the institution's graduate psychology program's chair attesting that the applicant has successfully fulfilled all educational requirements to earn the degree, but that due to the institution's schedule, the degree has not yet been conferred. The graduate transcript and the program chair's letter must be sent in sealed envelopes directly to the office of the Board of Psychology.

All other required application and registration of residency documentation must be provided to satisfy the application and registration of residency requirements.
