SUBJECT: Water - Design - Treatment - Fluoridation

Saturators for Fluoridation, a previous agreement made with the Division of Dental Health, allows certain design exceptions or provides clarifications for saturators as follows:

- 1. No separate room is required.
- 2. No scales/recorders are needed.
- 3. No dust collection equipment is needed.
- 4. Softening, if necessary, only the make-up water for the solution tank.
- 5. No need for two chemical pumps as fluoride is not needed to produce potable water.
