COMMUNITY HOUSING GUIDE HOUSING ROAD MAP

Instructions: Using information from the tenant screening, Community Housing Guides can assist individuals with developing a Housing Road Map with members of their person-centered planning team. The Housing Road Map guides the transition to independent housing and outlines how the person will achieve significant milestones in the transition process. The team can work on one milestone at a time or multiple milestones at the same time. However, a comprehensive plan will eventually address all of the milestones. Within each milestone, identify tasks the individual and the planning team must accomplish and "who will do what by when." Review the plan at least quarterly to track progress on outstanding tasks, celebrate milestones the team achieves, decide on new milestones and create new tasks. A Housing Road Map is a living process that involves revisiting milestones and adjusting plans based on new information and changes in resources or opportunities.
