SUBJECT: Regulations to implement the provisions of the Virginia Crimes Against Minors and Sex

Offender Registry, Chapter 9 of Title 9.1 of the Code of Virginia. — 19 VAC 30-170.

In response to a request from the Department of State Police, I have reviewed the proposed regulations, 19 VAC 30-170, relating to the regulations to implement the provisions of the Virginia Crimes Against Minors and Sex Offender Registry pursuant to Chapter 9 of Title 9.1 of the Code of Virginia. Virginia Code § 9.1-915 provides that the Department shall promulgate regulations and develop forms to implement and enforce provisions of the Virginia Crimes Against Minors and Sex Offender Registry, including the operation and maintenance of the Registry and the removal of records of persons who are deceased, whose convictions have been reversed or who have been pardoned, and those for whom an order of removal or relief from frequent registration has been entered. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the proposed regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by § 9.1-915 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions. Pursuant to § 9.1-915 of the Code of Virginia, the regulations are exempted from Article 2 (§ 2.2-4006 et. seq.) of the Administrative Process Act.
