The State Board of Elections ("the Board") meeting was held by electronic 2 communication on Wednesday, December 16, 2020. In attendance: Robert Brink, 3 Chairman, John O'Bannon, Vice Chairman, and Jamilah LeCruise, Secretary, represented 4 the State Board of Elections ("the Board"). Christopher E. "Chris" Piper, Commissioner 5 6 and Jessica Bowman, Deputy Commissioner, represented the Department of Elections ("ELECT") and Carol Lewis represented the Office of the Attorney General ("OAG"). 7 Chairman Brink called the meeting to order at 3:31 P.M. 8 9 Chairman Brink informed the Board that on March 12, 2020, Governor Ralph S. Northam declared that a state of emergency exists in the Commonwealth as the result of 10 the potential spread of COVID-19, a communicable disease presenting a threat to public 11 health. On March 30, 2020, the Governor issued an executive order requiring all 12 13 individuals in Virginia to remain at their place of residence, with certain enumerated exceptions. 14 15 This meeting was conducted consistent with the requirements for electronic 16 meetings by public bodies set forth in Items 4-0.01 of House Bills 29 and 30, as passed by the General Assembly ("GA") and signed by the Governor in April of this year. The 17 18 purpose of the meeting is to transact the statutorily required business of the Board. Chairman Brink stated that the Board would receive public comments on agenda items 19 prior to its action on that item, and an open public comment period would be offered 20 21 prior to adjournment.

The only item on the agenda was the consideration of an extension of the deadline 22 23 for filing under Va. Code § 24.2-503 presented by Paul Saunders, Elections 24 Administration Supervisor. Mr. Saunders informed the Board that the extension is for candidates in the Special Elections to be held on January 5, 2021. This memo is in the 25 Working Papers for the December 16, 2020 meeting. Chairman Brink opened the floor to 26 public comment. The Chairman stated that the Board was once again being put in the 27 unfair position of granting the extension, or keeping a candidate off the ballot. He 28 suggested that in the future the Board reassess the appropriateness of granting an 29 extension. The Chairman moved that the Board grant an extension pursuant to Virginia 30 31 Code § 24.2-503 for candidates to file the Certificate of Candidate Qualification or Statement of Economic Interests in relation to the special elections scheduled for January 32 5, 2021. Vice Chair O'Bannon seconded the motion and the motion passed 2-1. A roll 33 34 call vote was taken: Chairman Brink - Aye 35 Vice Chair O'Bannon – Aye 36 Secretary LeCruise - Nay 37 38 The Chairman opened the floor to public comment. Candi King, candidate running for the 2nd District House of Delegates addressed the Board. 39 Secretary LeCruise moved to adjourn the meeting. Vice Chair O'Bannon 40 41 seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously. A roll call vote was taken:
