CLOSED MEETING:

Upon a motion by Dr. Dowdy, and duly seconded by Dr. Ratliff, the Board voted 5-0, to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision regarding the matter of Andrea Major. Additionally, she moved that Ellen Shinaberry, Caroline Juran, Jim Rutkowski, and Sorayah Haden attend the closed meeting.

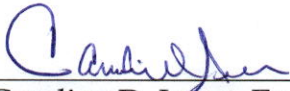
RECONVENE:

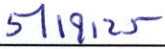
DECISION:
