and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy as stated in the March 10, 2025, Notice. Mr. Spangler was not represented by counsel.

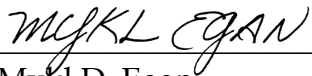
Based upon information provided by Ms. Ribley, Mr. Bolyard ruled that adequate notice was given to Mr. Spangler.
