WALLGREENS PHARMACY #17607 Permit No. 0201-003481	Derek Parvizi, Health Care Advisor and Lanny Mize, Director of Operations for Walgreens, appeared as representatives of Walgreens Pharmacy #17607 ("Walgreens #17607") to discuss allegations that it may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the conduct of a pharmacy as stated in the May 27, 2025, Notice and continued by letter dated August 11, 2025. The pharmacy was represented by Nora Ciancio, Esq. and Akina Moitra, Esq.
Closed Meeting:	Upon a motion by Mrs. Richards-Spruill, and duly seconded by Dr. Yuan, the Committee unanimously voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-3711(A)(27) for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Walgreens #17607. Additionally, she moved that Mykl Egan and Ileita Redd attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.

Reconvene:

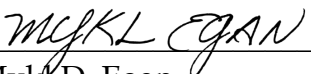
