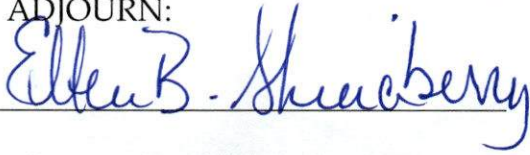
DECISION:

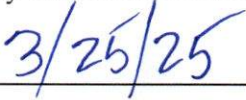
DECISION:
