A formal hearing was held in the matter of Alison Armbrister, pharmacy technician, to discuss allegations that she may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of pharmacy technicians in Virginia as provided in the notice dated March 11, 2025, and continued by notice dated March 31, 2025.

Jess Weber, Adjudication Specialist, presented the case for the Commonwealth. Ms. Armbrister was not present at the hearing and was not represented by counsel.

Joshua Hammett, Pharmacy Director of Express Care Pharmacy, testified in person on behalf of the Commonwealth.

CLOSED MEETING:

Upon a motion by Dr. Yuan, and duly seconded by Ms. Kale, the Board voted 8-0, to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711(A)(27) of the Code of Virginia ("Code"), for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision regarding the matter of Alison Armbrister. Additionally, she moved that Mykl Egan, Jim Rutkowski, and Sorayah Haden attend the closed meeting.

RECONVENE:

Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Board reconvened an open meeting and announced the decision. (Yuan/Dowdy)

Upon a motion by Dr. Dowdy, and duly seconded by Dr. Yuan, the Board voted 8-0 to accept the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as presented by the Commonwealth.
