FEDAH ABOABDO, PHARMACIST REINSTATEMENT APPLICANT License No. 0202-217102	Fedah Aboabdo did not appear to discuss her application for the reinstatement of her license to practice pharmacy and to review allegations that she may have violated certain laws and regulations regarding the practice of pharmacy as stated in the Notice dated November 25, 2025. She was represented by Lindsay Sessa, Esquire.

Reconvene:

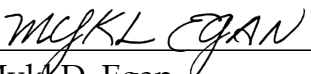
