Mr. Metheney moved to approve the agenda. Ms. Jackman seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Jackman and Metheny.

Approval of Agenda

Mr. Arvelo attended the meeting and asked about second day weigh-ins in Virginia. Mr. Arvelo also inquired about having Virginia regulate amateur bouts as it would protect the public in terms of the people fighting and it would create revenue for Virginia.

Public Comment Period

Procedures

Ms. Nosbisch informed Mr. Arvelo that the Board is in the process of proposing a regulatory change to do away with second day weigh-ins for boxing and upon counsel's advice, second day weigh-ins for mixed martial arts are not necessary.

Ms. Nosbisch indicated open cases cannot be discussed. At its last regulatory review meeting the Regulatory Review Committee proposed a change to the definition of exhibition which would address "smokers." This change is being recommended to the Director as a suggestion for the 2024 legislative package.

The Committee began a line-by-line review of the mixed martial arts regulations using the Regulatory Review Matrix Flowchart in order to determine the relevance of each regulation. During the review, the Committee began with 18VAC120-42-130. A long discussion took place regarding transgender contestants and how the Board will address this matter in the future. Mr. Haughwout recommended the Board and staff to conduct research in order to better understand the matter along with better understanding how other states or sanctioning organizations have approached the topic. The key topic of discussion surrounded the health and safety of the public. Ms. Nosbisch indicated she will discuss the matter with Board counsel for further guidance.

Regulatory Review

The Committee took a recess from 11:13 a.m. to 11:23 a.m.

Recess

The Committee continued reviewing the mixed martial arts regulations. The Committee will confer with Dr. Lee and Dr. Hardy about the affects of multiple TKOs and KOs. The Committee also decided to separate the rules for kickboxing, Muay Thai, full contact kickboxing, glory rules, and other similar contests within the mixed martial arts regulations to provide clarity to the requirements for each. The Committee ended on 18VAC120-42-190. The Committee will begin on 18VAC120-42-200 at the next meeting on June 5th at 10:00 a.m.
