Eleanor Brown opened the meeting by reciting: "As a result of the state of emergency declared in the Commonwealth by order of the Governor on March 12, 2020: Pursuant to Executive Amendment 28 to HB29 (2020), the Board of Trustees' Special Forestry Committee of the Virginia Outdoors Foundation (VOF) will meet by electronic communication means, without more than one Board member physically assembled at one location, to discuss or transact the business statutorily required or necessary to continue operations of VOF and the discharge of its lawful purposes, duties and responsibilities, as outlined in the meeting agenda. Due to the Governor's declared state of emergency, the meeting will be held electronically because the nature of the emergency makes it impracticable and unsafe to assemble in a single location. In addition, the purpose of the meeting is to discuss or transact business statutorily required to continue the operations of the Virginia Outdoors Foundation." Then roll was called.

## **Forest CORE Fund**

Emily White took the attendees through an overview of the 9 submitted applications and the associated charts in the meeting materials.

After consultation and discussion, the committee agreed to recommend to the full Board of Trustees the following projects and grant amounts.
