A motion was made by Mr. Boynton and seconded by Mr. Gifford to find reasonable cause against the respondents Randy Rockwitt and Kimberly Caswell for 1) refusing to negotiate for rental of the dwelling; 2) imposing discriminatory terms and conditions regarding rental of dwelling. FHB File Number 2012-02868, Leah and John Beckett v. Randy Rockwitt and Kimberly Caswall

In the matter of FHB File Number 2013-01092, Gertrude Davis and R. David Horslay v. Juanita Ann Carroll, a motion was made by Mr. Gifford and seconded by Ms. Wilson to approve the terms of the conciliation agreement as agreed to by the parties. The motion passed unanimously.
