## MINUTES

The State Board of Elections Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, November 6, 2012. The meeting was held in the Washington Building, Room B27, 1100 Bank Street, Richmond, Virginia. In attendance, representing the State Board of Elections (SBE) was Charles Judd, Chair; Kimberly Bowers, Vice-Chair; Donald Palmer, Secretary; Joshua Lief, Senior Assistant Attorney General and SBE Counsel; Justin Riemer, Deputy Secretary; and Nikki Sheridan, Special Advisor for Policy. Chairman Judd called the meeting to order at 9:00AM.

Chairman Judd motioned that the purpose of this meeting was to fulfill the State Board of Elections Board members' responsibility of fulfilling administrative duties related to the nationwide general elections occurring on that day. Secretary Palmer seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved the motion.

Vice-Chair Bowers then made a motion to recess. Chairman Judd seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved the motion. The Board reconvened at 9:00 PM. Chairman Judd inquired if there were any comments by members of the Board or Counsel. Joshua Lief, Senior Assistant Attorney General and SBE Counsel, offered a motion to the Chairman regarding administrative duties required by the Secretary of SBE on Election Day. Chairman Judd under the advice of counsel made the motion that the State Board authorize the Secretary to either commence litigation or defend litigation on behalf of the Board, if required during this Election Day. Chairman Judd noted that this motion was made to ensure necessary actions are taken and in an abundance of caution. Vice-Chair Bowers seconded the motion and the Board unanimously approved the motion. The Board shall reconvene on November 26, 2012 at 10:00AM. Chairman Judd asked for any public comments. There being none, the meeting adjourned at approximately 9:15PM.
