The Committee discussed the need to prepare a guidance document to address the documentation needed in order to register supervision because Regulation 18VAC115-20-52.B.10. provides that residents shall not engage in practice under supervision in any areas for which they have not had appropriate education. As such, documentation of internship, coursework outline, and job description is required before any supervised experience is approved.

DECISION:

The Credentials Committee requested additional coursework on five (5) files. The Committee denied six (6) applications. Two applications were approved.
