Additionally, he moved that Ms. Brown, Ms. Larimer, Mr. Opper, and Ms. Lipinski attend the closed meeting, because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
<b>RECONVENE:</b>	Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee reconvened in open session and announced its decision.

**DECISION:** Upon a motion by Mr. Falk and duly seconded by Ms. Benson, the Committee made certain Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and voted to reprimand Dr. Kothari and place him on probation with terms and conditions.

Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of this Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
