CFPF Round 4 Scoring and Recommendations - Studies

#### Explanation of CFPF Award Recommendations

- <u>Approve</u>, for applications that met the category eligibility requirements and scoring threshold. Note that this applies to the application itself, and not necessarily to the amount requested. Awards may ultimately be lower than requests, based on funding availability.
- <u>Conditional</u>, for applications that met the category eligibility requirements and scoring threshold, but which had minor technical deficiencies. These awards would be made conditionally upon the applicant fulfilling Department requirements.
- <u>Further Discussion Required</u>, for projects that are being advanced to the group without a recommendation, and where the Department is requesting feedback from the Review Committee.
- <u>Decline</u>, for applications that met the category eligibility requirements, but not the scoring threshold. As presented, this applies only to the "project" category, and to applications within that category that fall below 70 points. The Review Committee may wish to consider whether to recommend some of the projects in this category for conversion into loans, if the applicant is interested.
- <u>Ineligible</u>, for applications which did not meet the category or application requirements.
