CLOSED MEETING: Dr. Gleason moved that the Special Conference Committee of the Board of Nursing convene a closed meeting pursuant to 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the *Code of Virginia* at 9:36 A.M. for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Angela Gail Mills. Additionally, Dr. Gleason moved that Ms. Bargdill and Mr. Robinson attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting is deemed necessary, and their presence will aid the Committee in its deliberations. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

ACTION: Dr. Gleason moved to Issue an Order to Approve Angela Gail Mills' Application for licensure as a Massage Therapist by endorsement and issue an unrestricted license contingent upon successful completion of 24 hours of continued competency within 90 days of the Order. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

An Order will be entered. As provided by law, this decision shall become a Final Order thirty days after service of such Order on Ms. Mills, unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against him is received from Ms. Mills within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail, three additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the Order shall be vacated.

The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

This Consent Order shall be effective upon endorsement of its findings, conclusions, and terms of consent by both Qun Shen and the Board. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

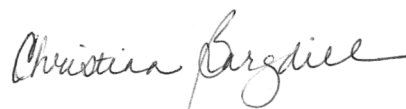
ACTION:
