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Ms. Brooks informed the Board members that the proposed regulations were returned to the Governor's office on February 16, 2006, and are currently under review for approval.

The Board members reviewed and discussed the proposed Auctioneers Board Regulations. Ms. Wang moved that the Board adopt the amended draft as proposed regulations. Ms. Wang further moved to authorize staff, in conjunction with the Chair, to make any minor changes as necessary, on behalf of the Board, so that the regulations can be approved. Ms. Pence seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Garten, Pence, Perkinson, and Wang.

Consideration of Revisions to Regulations

The Board members reviewed the summary prepared by staff regarding possible reciprocal agreements with New Hampshire, Massachusetts and Wisconsin. New Hampshire appeared to be the only state similar to Virginia's regulations; therefore, staff recommends approval of a reciprocal agreement with New Hampshire. Ms. Wang moved to accept New Hampshire for a reciprocal agreement for those individuals that completed the New Hampshire auctioneer school training and passed the New Hampshire auctioneer examination. Ms. Pence seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Garten, Pence, Perkinson, and Wang.

<u>Update on Reciprocal</u> Agreements

Ms. Wang further moved not to approve the states of Massachusetts and Wisconsin for reciprocal agreements as it appears that their entry requirements are not equivalent to Virginia's. Ms. Pence seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Garten, Pence, Perkinson, and Wang.

The Board members were provided with the February 2006 financial statements for informational purposes. The Board members were also provided with a handout containing a financial analysis and fee decrease recommendation for the Board. Mr. Perkinson requested that the Board review the information and be prepared to vote at its next meeting in July to decrease the Board's fees.

Ms. Brooks reminded the Board members that elections for Chair and Vice-Chair will be held at the next Board meeting in July.
