**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Proposed Regulations – Proposed Amendments to Title 55

Recodification — Time-Share Regulations found at 18VAC48-45

I have reviewed the Common Interest Community Board's Proposed Amendments to Title 55

Recodification — Time-Share Regulations found at 18VAC48-45 that were posted on the Virginia Regulatory

Town Hall on October 14, 2019. In my view, as counsel to the Common Interest Community Board, these
regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Titles 54.1 and 55 of the Code of Virginia. The regulations do not
appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of

Virginia, nor do they appeal to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. Further, I certify that
the proposed changes are exempt from the Administrative Process Act under Code of Virginia §§ 2.2
4006(A)(4) as the changes are "[n]ecessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation
act where no agency discretion is involved."

This memorandum addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
