The Medicaid authority as established by § 1902 (a) of the *Social Security Act* [42 U.S.C. 1396a] provides governing authority for payments for services.

Chapter 795 of the 2012 Acts of Assembly mandated that agencies' public participation guidelines permit interested persons to be accompanied by and be represented by counsel during while providing comments during the agency's public comment periods.
