**SUBJECT:** Proposed repeal of 22 VAC 40-170

Voluntary Registration of Family Day Homes – Requirements for Contracting Organizations

I have reviewed the above-referenced proposed regulation repeal to determine whether the State Board of Social Services ("the Board") has the statutory authority to repeal the specified regulation.

Pursuant to Va. Code § 63.2-217, the State Board is required to promulgate regulations as may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes of Va. Code § 63.1-100, *et seq*. Additionally, the Board is specifically charged with promulgating regulations to carry out the statutory mandate in § 63.2-319 to protect children and strengthen families.

Consequently, it is my opinion that the Board has the authority to repeal these regulations, subject to compliance with the provisions of Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act and Executive Order 36 (2006), and has not exceeded that authority.
