## **MEMORANDUM**

- Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident Concealed Handgun Carry Permits (Final) -SUBJECT: 19 VAC 30-190-10, et seq.

In response to a request from the Department of State Police, I have reviewed the regulations, 19 VAC 30-190-10, et seq., relating to the issuance of nonresident concealed handgun carry permits. Virginia Code § 18.2-308(P)(1) requires the Superintendent of the State Police to promulgate regulations, pursuant to the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.), for the implementation of an application process for obtaining such permits. Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, I find the regulations, in their final stage, to be constitutional, consistent with the statutory authority granted by § 18.2-308 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
