Re: Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident Concealed Handgun Carry Permits – 19 VAC 30-190

Dear All:

I have reviewed the regulations set forth in 19 VAC 30-190, Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident Concealed Handgun Carry Permits.

Regulation 19 VAC 30-190 is being amended in accordance with EO-19, which directed all executive agencies review their regulations to eliminate unnecessary mandates.

Upon review of the aforesaid regulation, I find the changes to be consistent with the statutory authority conferred by § 18.2-308.06 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions. The changes to the regulations are exempted from the Administrative Process Act pursuant to §§ 2.2-4002(B)(6) of the Code of Virginia.

The regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitution of the United States or the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they appear to conflict with any federal or state law currently in effect. This approval addresses legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the action.
