Makes technical corrections to and eliminates some sections from the Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident Concealed Handgun Carry Permits following a full review of the Regulation as mandated by Executive Order 19. This Action amends sections 19VAC30-190-20 and 19VAC30-190-110. These changes resulted in the removal of one mandate.

Mandate and Impetus

Executive Order 19 (EO-19) and Executive Directive 1 (ED-1) ordered all Executive Branch Agencies of the Commonwealth to review all their regulations with a focus on ensuring agency regulatory requirements are enacted in a manner so as to ensure they meet the needs of the Commonwealth while imposing the least burden and cost on business and citizens of the Commonwealth. As a result of that review these amendments make technical corrections to the Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident Concealed Handgun Carry Permits.

On September 26,2023, the Virginia State Police adopted final amended regulations for 19VAC30-190, Regulations Relating to the Issuance of Nonresident Concealed Handgun Carry Permits. The amendments alter certain sections in 19VAC30-190 as follows:

- **19VAC30-190-20** How to Apply. The requirement that a brochure be provided has been removed. The Supreme Court of Virginia is statutorily mandated to provide this information on their website. Removes one discretionary mandate.
- 19VAC30-190-110 Change of address. The section was reorganized to encourage electronic reporting of change of address and to update the mailing address for such requests.
