**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for Amended Regulations for Occupational Exposure to COVID-19 —

Emergency Temporary Standard, Interim Final Rule found at 16VAC25-90-1910.502; 16

VAC25-90-1910.504; 16 VAC25-90-1910.505; and 16 VAC25-90-1910.509

I have reviewed the Department of Labor and Industry's proposed Amended Regulations for Occupational Exposure to COVID–19 — Emergency Temporary Standard, Interim Final Rule found at 16VAC25-90-1910.502; 16 VAC25-90-1910.504; 16 VAC25-90-1910.505; and 16 VAC25-90-1910.509 that was posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall on July 7, 2021. In my view, as counsel to the Department of Labor and Industry, these regulations may be promulgated pursuant to Title 40.1 of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>. Further, I certify that the proposed changes are exempt from the Administrative Process Act under <u>Code of Virginia</u> § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(c) as they are necessary to meet the requirements of federal law or regulations and they do not materially differ from those required by federal law or regulation. This memorandum addresses

legal matters only and is not intended to serve, nor should it be construed, as a comment for or against the merits of the proposed regulations.
