  - b. Is it unconsolidated mineral material? Yes or No
  - c. Is it consolidated mineral material? Yes or No
  - d. If yes to either b or c, continue to Question No. 3.
- 3. Will mineral be processed, either on or off site before use? Yes or No
  - a. If yes, a DMM permit will be required for this activity.
    - b. If no, continue to Question No. 4.
- 4. Will the mineral be used as fill. **Yes or No**.
  - a. If no, a DMM permit will be required for this activity.
  - b. If yes, the answer the following questions.
    - 1) Will fill be used on-site or adjacent to the excavation? Yes or No
      - a) If yes, refer to the local soil and erosion control agency.
      - b) If no, continue to next question.
    - 2) Will fill be used by the operator? Yes or No
      - a) If no, a DMM permit will be required for this activity.
      - b) If yes, continue to next question.
    - 3) Will fill material be sold or exchanged? Yes or No
      - a) If yes, a DMM permit will be required for this activity.
      - b) If no, continue to Question No. 5
- 5. Is excavation activity planned to operate only one-time or only intermittently? **Yes or No**.
  - a. If yes, refer to the local soil and erosion control agency.
  - b. If no, refer to the DMM OMT for further analysis
