BOARD POLICY NUMBER: 20-8

SUBJECT: Extending Limits of Confinement for Work and Educational Programs

DATE: June 1, 2013

- 20-8.1 POLICY The Board of Corrections recognizes that programs outside a correctional facility enhance rehabilitation of certain prisoners through work, educational, and other related community activity programs.

Subject to approval by the Board, the Department shall develop general guidelines to establish work release programs that provide criteria for the operation of, and participation in, those programs. The Director and any sheriff or other administrative head of any local correctional facility may enter into agreements for placement of state prisoners in appropriate local work release programs. Agreements shall address prisoner wages and deductions as prescribed by Section [53.1-60](#) of the Code of Virginia.
