SUBJECT: Regional Contracts for Cooperative Jailing of Offenders

DATE: June 1, 2013

30-7.1 <u>POLICY</u> The Board of Corrections recognizes the authority of, and need for, localities to contract for detention services in local or regional jail facilities operated by contracting jurisdictions. Localities may contract with local or regional jail facilities to detain or confine their prisoners pursuant to regulations promulgated by the Board, which specify the categories of offenders that may be served under the contract.

Contracts, approved by the Board that require construction, enlargement or renovation of a regional jail facility or an existing jail, shall require the locality to participate in the costs of the facility for a minimum period of thirty years. The Commonwealth shall reimburse the locality or localities its pro rata share, up to one-half of the cost of such construction, enlargement or renovation. Such reimbursement shall be paid from funds appropriated to the Department of Corrections.

The Board of Corrections shall promulgate regulations specifying the categories of offenders who may be served pursuant to such contracts. The Board shall promulgate regulations, to include criteria to be used to assess need, assist in establishing priorities, and serve as guidelines in evaluating requests for state funds. Such regulations shall be applied by the Department in preparing requests for appropriations.
