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Code of Virginia § 54.1-201(A)(5) gives authority to the Board to promulgate regulations. It states, in part, that the Board has the power and duty "[t]o promulgate regulations in accordance with the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.) necessary to assure continued competency, to prevent deceptive or misleading practices by practitioners and to effectively administer the regulatory system administered by the regulatory board."

The purpose of the Board is to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public who receive esthetics services by ensuring those who are licensed to practice are minimally competent and that minimum standards of practice are sufficient to ensure safety. It is not the role of the Board to enhance the profession or reputation of the industry. Once the training standards of performing the services safely are met, students should be eligible to obtain a license.

### **Effectiveness**

The regulation meets the criteria set forth in the Office of Regulatory Management procedures. The regulation is necessary for the protection of public health, safety, and welfare and is clearly written and understandable.

Code of Virginia §§ 54.1-201(A)(1) and 54.1-201(A)(5) mandate the Board promulgate regulations. The continued need for the regulation is established in statute. Repeal of the regulation would remove the current public protections provided by the regulation. The Board provides protection to the safety and welfare of the citizens of the Commonwealth by ensuring that only those individuals that meet specific criteria set forth in the statutes and regulations are eligible to receive a esthetician, master esthetician, instructor, salon, or school license, or temporary permit. The Board is also tasked with ensuring that its regulants meet standards of practice that are set forth in the regulations.

The public comments received addressed concerns regarding the Board's future discussion of reducing or combining the Esthetics and Master Esthetics curriculum and licenses. The Board has formed a Regulatory Advisory Panel to review this subject.

The Esthetics Regulations are clearly written, easily understandable, and do not overlap, duplicate or conflict with federal or state law or regulation.

The most recent periodic review of the regulation occurred in 2019. Currently, the Board is conducting a comprehensive review of the regulation.
