

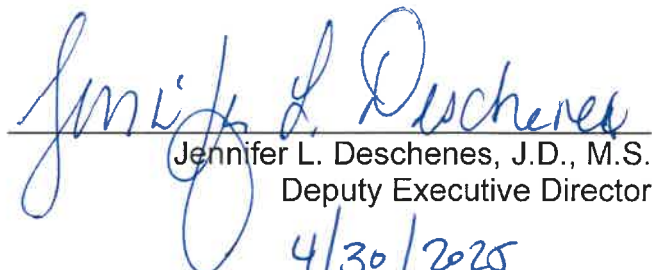

SPECIAL CONFERENCE COMMITTEE MINUTES APRIL 30, 2025

- CALL TO ORDER:** A Special Conference Committee of the Board was called to order at 9:04 a.m.

- MATTER:** **John Stuart Mancoll, M.D.** **License No.: 0101-054100**
Case Nos.: 213726, 226151
- DISCUSSION:** Dr. Mancoll appeared before the Committee in person in accordance with an Amended Notice of the Board dated April 3, 2025. Dr. Mancoll was represented by Michael L. Goodman, Esquire.
- The Committee fully discussed the allegations in the Notice with Dr. Mancoll.
- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Vaughan, and duly seconded by Dr. Lucas, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A(16) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of consideration and discussion of medical and mental health records of Dr. Mancoll. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Hines attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its discussion.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and continued its discussion with Dr. Mancoll regarding the allegations.

- CLOSED SESSION:** Upon a motion by Dr. Vaughan, and duly seconded by Dr. Lucas, the Committee voted to convene a closed meeting pursuant to §2.2-3711.A (27) of the Code of Virginia, for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of Dr. Mancoll. Additionally, he moved that Ms. Deschenes and Ms. Hines attend the closed meeting because their presence in the closed meeting was deemed necessary and would aid the Committee in its deliberations.
- RECONVENE:** Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed session met the requirements of §2.2-3712 of the Code, the Committee re-convened in open session and announced its decision.
- DECISION:** Dr. Vaughan made a motion to issue Dr. Mancoll a reprimand and enter HPMP but it was not seconded. Upon a motion by Dr. Lucas, and duly seconded by Mr. Marchese, the Committee made certain findings of fact and conclusions of law and voted to issue Dr. Mancoll a reprimand.
- VOTE:** The vote was 2 to 1.
- ADJOURNMENT:** The Committee adjourned at 12:51 p.m.

As provided by law this decision shall become a Final Order thirty (30) days after service of such Order on Dr. Mancoll, unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against him is received from Dr. Mancoll, within such time. If service of the Order is made by mail three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the decision of the Special Conference Committee shall be vacated.
